What and Who ?

What does he like ?

He likes **chocolate**.

What kind/what sort of chocolate does he like?

He likes **dark** chocolate.

What is he doing? (=qu'est ce qu'il est en train de faire ?)

He is **cleaning the bathroom**.

What does he do? (=quel métier fait-il?)

He's **a teacher**.

What does `damp` mean ?

'Damp' means '**cold and wet**'

What day is it today?

It's **Monday**.

What date is it today?

It's **March 4th**.

What size shoes does she take?

She takes size **38** shoes.

What do you call a Scottish church?

You call a Scottish church a **kirk**.

What time is he coming?

He's coming **at seven o'clock**.

What is a corkscrew for?

A corkscrew is for **opening bottles with**.

What happened yesterday?

Aunt Sally came to see us yesterday.

What's the weather **like**?

It's **raining**.

She is **very ill**.

How can I help?
You can help **by washing the dishes**.

How deep is the swimming-pool?
It's **five metres** deep.

How far(away) is it to the nearest bank?
The nearest bank is **ten kilometres** away.

How fast can that train travel?
That train can travel **at 190 k.p.h.**

How high is that tree?
That tree is **over thirty metres** high.

How late is the train?
The train is **nearly half an hour** late.

How long is the table?
The table is **nearly two metres** long.

How long did she go there for?
She went there for **ten week**.

How long ago did she die?
She died **five years** ago.

How many bottles of milk did you get?
I got **five** bottles of milk.

How much cheese did you eat?
I ate **100 grams** of cheese.

How much did your car cost?
My car cost **far too** much.

How often do they write to you?
They write to me **twice a month**.

How old is she?
She's **twenty-five**.

How tall is Nick?
Nick is **one metre eighty centimetres tall**.

The lake is **ten kilometres** wide.

She got here **last night**.

I'm going to start my judo lessons **next Wednesday**.

I'll know the result of the tests **next week**.

I went **to the pictures**.

They went there **to play football**.
